A reminder of what EDCHL provides:

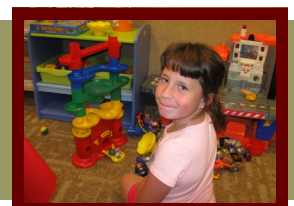
- **Fun!** Participants will have the chance to play games and engage in entertaining activities.
