Dear 2011 camp families,
 We just finished our first summer of testing at the Early Development of Children with Hearing Loss (EDCHL) "data camps". Sixty children and their families from all over the country participated. The data we collect at our summer camps helps us understand the development of children with hearing loss. Your child's participation in this project is extremely important and we appreciate your willingness to continue participating. There are several good research studies involving the development of children with hearing loss, but none has as large a group of children being followed over time as EDCHL.

The first step towards your participation next summer is for you to pick a camp date. Please see the other side of this flyer for dates.



Make 3 choices in order of preference and let us know as soon as possible!

Here are a few details to make sure you are informed about these data camps.

- ◆ All testing will take place in Columbus, OH at The Ohio State University.
- ◆ You will be here for two days.
- ◆ We will take care of all the arrangements including:
 - *Reimbursement for driving expenses or purchasing plane tickets for one parent and the child participating in the camp*
 - *Hotel with a pool (room sleeps 4, so extra family members can be in the room at no additional cost) for 2 nights*
 - *All meals for one parent and child participating while you are here*
 - *Transportation to and from the airport, the hotel, and the university*

Other family or friends are welcome but will need to pay for their own transportation (flights) to Ohio.

What will you and your child get from participating in the summer 2011 data camp?

- Some information about your child's development
- Fun times and valuable experiences interacting with other children and parents
- \$150.00 for taking your valuable time to help with this project
